Re: European Commission Directive 2009/251/EC of 17 March 2009 regarding DMF

Tyco Electronics is aware of the above referenced Directive restricting the use of dimethyl fumarate (DMF). As of the date of this letter we have confirmed that DMF is not contained in any TE products. With respect to product packaging materials, Tyco Electronics does not specify the use of DMF (an anti fungal agent typically used with furniture or footwear) in any case. However, as a precaution we are currently verifying with our supply chain that there is no use of DMF associated with certain packaging materials that are used for a limited number of Tyco Electronics products. We are nearly complete with this activity with no usage of DMF identified to date. This information is provided based on reasonable inquiry of our suppliers and represents our current actual knowledge based on the information provided by our suppliers.
