DESCRIPTION

PRODUCT COVERED:

Component - .070 Series Multi-Lok I/O Connectors.

GENERAL:

These devices are multi-pole employing pin type contacts intended for installation on printed wiring boards for use within electrical equipment. The .070 Series Multi-Lok I/O Connectors have a row of spacing of $5.9~\mathrm{mm}$ and a min pitch of $3.5~\mathrm{mm}$.

ENGINEERING CONSIDERATIONS (NOT FOR UL REPRESENTATIVE USE):

 $\underline{\text{Use}}$ - For use only in complete equipment where the acceptability of the combination is determined by **UL LLC.**

<u>Conditions of Acceptability</u> - In order to be considered acceptable as a component of electrical equipment, the following conditions should be met.

- 1. These devices should be used only where they will not interrupt the current.
 - 2. These devices have not been tested for current carrying capability.
- 3. The suitability of the mounting means shall be determined in the $\!\!$ end use.
- 4. The placement of these devices within the equipment enclosure should show that spacings between the live parts and the equipment are suitable for the particular application.
- 5. The adjacent poles may be used at potentials not exceeding $250\ V$ based on the spacing requirements of UL 1977. Dielectric testing has not been performed.
- 6. The electrical and mechanical contact between the connector and the printed wiring board is to be judged in the end-use equipment.
- 7. The suitability of the insulating materials used in the molded bodies shall be judged in the end-use equipment.

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- 8. The electrical and mechanical suitability of the wiring terminals shall be determined in the end use.
- 9. The operating temperature of these devices should not exceed the temperature ratings of the insulating materials. These materials may be used interchangeably at a maximum temperature of $75\,^{\circ}\text{C}$.
