TE is familiar with the principles of the Responsible Business Association (RBA), Social Accountability International's SA8000 standard, Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises, and other customer codes of conduct. <u>TE's Guide to Ethical Conduct</u> includes programs, policies, and practices that embody the principles set forth by these organizations. Through these efforts, TE was named a <u>World's Most Ethical Company by Ethisphere</u> for the eleventh consecutive year in 2025.

To reinforce TE's policies on human rights, TE became a signatory of the <u>United Nations Global Compact</u> in 2011 and committed to communicating progress on the ten principles, which align with the core values of TE Connectivity.
